

PHA RANGE RULES

NO FULLY AUTOMATIC WEAPONS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE RANGE PROPERTY AT ANYTIME.

1. NO alcoholic beverages will be permitted on range property at any time.
2. Range facilities are for the use of PHA members and guests. The PHA member is responsible for their guests' conduct and use of Range facilities. Please limit the number of guests to 2 per Range member per visit. This will help maintain compliance with the safety rules.
3. Range hours are from sun up to sun down Monday through Sunday.
4. Prior to firing on range, check beyond the back stop and make sure NO one is down range. SAFETY FIRST!!!
5. Shooters on the firing line are to be alert for range commands.
6. No firing of any weapons will be permitted on the range other than in the designated firing areas provided.
7. Any individual firing on the range must comply with all rules and regulations pertaining to firearms safety and the operation of the range.
8. Strict discipline must be maintained while on the range. Carelessness and "Horseplay" will NOT be tolerated. One accident is all it takes to close our range.
9. Never break the 180 degree line. Be sure of your target and what is around it.
10. Never go down range until the firing line has been called and everyone is in a safe location.
11. All children under the age of 16 must be under the direct supervision of an adult while shooting and all

- children (ages 10-15) must be under direct supervision of an adult while on the range property.
12. Treat all guns as if LOADED!!! Never assume that a firearm is unloaded. Always double check to make sure that your gun is unloaded. All guns must be kept unloaded with action open except when on the firing line ready to fire. all actions must be open and the gun laying on the stand before the range can be declared "SAFE".
 13. Always obey the range officer or any fellow officer of the Club at all times, regardless of the circumstances.
 14. No shooting of metal targets with center fire bottleneck rifle cartridges. All metal targets are for pistol and rim fire rifles only. Anyone caught shooting metal targets with a center fire rifle will be required to pay for the damaged targets and will lose their membership in PHA.
 15. No shooting of bottles, cans, or rocks are allowed. Only appropriate targets and appropriate ammunition should be used at each site.
 16. Common shooting courtesy must be used!! Let others post and check their targets when necessary.
 17. PHA members and their guest are required to clean up after themselves before leaving. Rule of Thumb: Whatever you bring with you, take out with you. Try and leave the range cleaner than when you arrived. Trash cans have been provided for your use. **USE THEM!**
 18. When handling a firearm, always keep the barrel pointed down range and under your control at all times.
 19. Never put your finger on the gun trigger until you are ready to shoot at your targets.
 20. Eye and ear protection are required for **ALL** shooters and spectators while on the range.
 21. No animals are permitted to be brought on the range

property at any time.
